

Public Transportation in Budapest

Tickets have to be bought before boarding; you cannot usually buy them from the driver and there are no conductors. Tickets must be purchased in advance at tobacco shops or metro stations. Weekly passes allowing free travel on all means of transportation within the city borders can be bought at all main metro stations.

- a) Single ticket (one way): 290 Ft
- b) Single transfer ticket (return ticket): 450 Ft
- c) Book of 10 tickets: 2600 Ft
- d) 2-day family ticket: 2100 Ft, valid for maximum 2 adults and 2 children under the age of 18 for two calendar days.
- e) 1-day unlimited travel card: 1500 Ft
- f) 3-day unlimited travel card: 3700 Ft
- g) 7-day unlimited travel card: 4400 Ft
- h) Metro Section Ticket: 240 Ft, available exclusively for use of the Metro for a maximum of 3 stops

i) Budapest Card

for 48 hours = 6300 Forint (~ 21,-€)

for 72 hours = 7500 Forint (~ 25,-€)

Services:

- unlimited travel on public transportation
- free or discounted entry to 60 museums and to several sights
- sightseeing tour for half price
- reduced price tickets for cultural and folklore programmes
- discounts in restaurants and spas

The card is available in the main metro ticket offices, tourist information bureaus, hotels and at the airport.
